# Action D.5 - Monitoring of communication activities: Opinion poll about Natura 2000 in Slovenia 2022

#### **English summary**

## Description of the purpose - planned and executed activities:

Zavod Štirna has implemented second public opinion poll in 2022 in cooperation with the research agency Parsifal SC about Natura 2000 in Slovenia (first was implemented in 2019). There was significantly bigger share of those who have heard about Natura 2000 and who think that Natura 2000 are nature protected areas. The next public opinion poll will be implemented in 2024.

#### Methodology

Opinion poll about Natura 2000 in Slovenia (December 2019, September 2022) is a quantitative research based on the CATI method (Computer Aided Telephone Interviews). It has included 1,007 people in 2019 and 1,004 in 2022.

With the opinion poll, we were looking for the information about knowing and understanding Natura 2000, experiences with Natura 2000, Natura 2000's impact of different activities, agriculture and Natura 2000, forestry and Natura 2000, understanding of nature conservation and activities of nature conservation.

#### Outcomes and results in comparison 2019 and 2022:

The mayor part (39,5%) of respondents agree that Natura 2000 is about nature protected areas.	The mayor part (43,8%) of respondents agree that Natura 2000 is about nature protected areas.	4,3%	11%

Among demographic groups there are in general no major differences between 2019 and 2022. No major differences are also among the farmers and forester in comparison to general attitude. Some additional data from 2022 public opinion poll:

- 66,3% responents thought that Natura 2000 is limiting agriculture
- 48,0% respondents answered that there are different activities allowed in Natura 2000
- Around half of the respondents thought that different activities have an positive impact on nature in Slovenia (water management 61,8%; forestry 57,5%, agriculture 44,4%). In comparision with 2019 there was a bigger share of those who think that economic development has a negative impact on nature and those who think that tourism has a negative impact on nature.

#### **Conslusions**

There were statistically significant positive changes in public opinion poll on two answers, which are being monitored as a result also in the project documentation. In two years time of strategic communication led and implemented by Zavod Štirna in LIFE-IP NATURA.SI has resulted in opinion poll.

The opinion poll about Natura 2000 is the second of three planned opinion polls in 8 years of LIFE-IP NATURA.SI project. It is beneficial not just for our project but also for different sectors when planning communication in nature conservation.
